### **Committee Reports:**

**Lake:** Scott Kreutz reported that a meeting was held with Jack Boyer about how to proceed with the project. A lot of trees will have to be removed before proceeding.

The plan is to have a depth of 12' at the drain and as much 10' depth as possible in the middle. Will add about 10' of shore line.

Bill working with Snowmobile Club on having 3-D shoots using their targets. The income would be split 50/50.
