PISTOL RANGE RULES

1. Shooting Hours are 9:00am until Sunset.
2. A parent or responsible adult member must accompany children under 16 years of age
3. All members must possess a current membership on their person at all times while on **S. R. S. C.** property.
4. Hearing and eye protection must be worn while firing is in progress
5. Assume all firearms are loaded and may discharge. Therefore, keep all firearms pointed downrange at all times.
6. Alcoholic beverages or drugs of any kind are never allowed on the firing line, or people under the influence of it.
7. The shooters must agree among themselves whether the line is "safe" or "hot".
8. Do not handle firearms when the line has been declared "safe" or if anyone is in front of the firing line.
9. When the firing line is "safe", firearms must be in the box, or on the bench with magazines out, slides locked back, or cylinders open.
10. Once the firing line has been declared "hot", you may handle, load, and shoot firearms.
11. Paper targets and clay birds are the only targets permitted on the pistol range.
12. Shooting at bottles, cans, or "plinking", is never permitted anywhere on Slippery Rock Sportsmen's Club property.
13. No rapid fire on range, all shots must be aimed.
14. Rifle and shotguns are not permitted on the pistol range.
15. Be considerate of other shooters and guests.
16. A member is permitted to bring guests but no more than two guests per visits at a time.

Please Note: Since Slippery Rock Sportsmen's Club is not just an Pistol Facility some or all of the Practice Range and/or other Ranges may need to be closed during a scheduled **Club Event** or **Work Day** for maintenance or safety reasons. Please check with one of the Club Officers if you have any questions. For any questions about the Pistol Range or to form a committee can be submitted at the club meeting.
